

**REQUIREMENTS IN RESPECT OF CERTIFICATES OF FITNESS ISSUED BY THE  
SOUTH AFRICAN DEEP SEA ANGLING ASSOCIATION**

**In terms of Regulation 21 of the Merchant Shipping  
(Small Vessel Safety) Regulations, 2002,**

**In respect of unregistered pleasure vessels (non-commercial) under 100GT**

**Category "E"- Up to 1 Nautical Miles**

- Fee paid
- One water tight capsized bottle with lanyard the width of the boat readily accessible in the event of capsized and to contain the following:
  - 1 x Unexpired approved flare set.
  - 1 x Unexpired approved hand held smoke marker.
  - 1 x first aid kit
  - 1 x waterproof torch complete with spare batteries and spare bulb.(night only)
- 1 approved life jacket, with a whistle attached to it, for each person on the boat
- One approved 1.5kg dry powder fire extinguisher per motor. These have to be serviced once a year.
- A Capsized rope, suitable for the type of vessel.
- A suitable anchor for the area
- 3m of 6mm galvanised chain for vessels less than 6m
- 5m of 6mm galvanised chain for vessels of more than 6m
- 50m of suitable anchor rope.
- A suitable Sea Anchor rigged for surf launching with trip line and hawser (Surf Launch only)
- Step down cabin boats to be fitted with suitable bilge pump or lip at entrance
- Bow eye and stern eye
- Anchor bollard
- Suitable scuppers
- Kill switch/s
- Emergency / Alternative Steering
- Two paddles or oars (If only one motor)
- Suitable bailing device (If no wet deck)
- Petrol tanks to be suitable and S.A.M.S.A approved.
- Inflatable's to have air bellows and repair kit.
- A tool kit
- Spares
- For night operation, the boat must be equipped with navigation lights and an all round white light
- Registration number on both sides of the vessel/craft
- All safety equipment to be on board and marked with boats number.
- The boat trailer to be marked with boat's number and the owner's telephone number.
- Battery and fuel tank to be in separate compartments.
- The buoyancy must enable craft to form a platform (calculation)
  - Copy ID
  - Copy Buoyancy certificate
  - Copy Skipper's Licence
  - Photo of boat
  - SAMSA form filled in
